## **KOREA'S NEW MARTIAL LAWS**



South Korea is currently going through a large political crisis. On December 3rd 22:27 at local time, Yoon suk-yeol, the president of South Korea stated through television that he was imposing martial law nationwide. He reasoned that the opposition party is currently doing "anti-state activities" and is cooperating with North Korea's communists to destroy the country.

This declaration of martial law caused all political activities to be suspended. Freedom of speech was restricted and the press was under control of the government.

#### **Martial law**

Martial law is declared by the president when there are emergencies happening in the country such as rebellion or war, the time when public safety cannot be preserved. It allows the military to substitute the civilian government and have unlimited authority to make and enforce laws. The martial law can happen only under the parliament's agreement.

South Korea previously went through martial law 9 times, which all led to the dictatorship of presidents. The martial law announced by president Yoon disturbed the peace and democracy of the country that was maintained over 45 years.

#### The end of martial law

The martial law was ended by the National Assembly of Korea. Even though there were armies and police guarding around the parliament not to let anyone inside, members of parliament entered the building successfully; some with help of citizens and others even climbed over the fence. The martial law army tried to stop them afterwards, however every entrance and windows were already blocked and defended. The 190 members inside passed the resolution for the president to lift martial law. This process was done under 6 hours, showing how fast and desperate they were.

#### Following consequences

Many politicians, experts and citizens believe that martial law was declared to defend the president himself from political attacks. The president was accused of treason and his approval rate dropped to 13%- the lowest in the entire world. Millions of people are protesting for the impeachment of the president all over the nation.

The martial law also had an impact on other things. The exchange rate of won and dollar dropped drastically and numbers of countries were not accepting won for exchange. The military discharge was postponed temporarily, which caused even more hate for the president.

## **LUIGI MANGIONE, SHOT**

#### UnitedHealthcare CEO's Death

Brian Thompson, the CEO of UnitedHealthcare, was fatally shot outside a luxury hotel in midtown manhattan on December 4 in what has been described as a premeditated attack. The alleged shooter, 26-year-old software developer Luigi Mangione, was arrested in Pennsylvania days later after a Mcdonald's worker called it in and will face charges including first-degree murder. Investigators have been led to believe the attack as the three bullets were found to have inscriptions - delay, deny, depose - phrases widely known as critics towards the health insurance industry including companies like United Healthcare. Law enforcement sources say this may be a reference to the "three D's of insurance" - tactics used by companies to reject payment claims by patients.

Brian Thompson, 50, was a prominent figure in the healthcare insurance industry as the chief executive officer of one of the largest insurance providers in the United States. However over recent years, since he gained control, his company has gained public criticism for allegations of unethical practices and people claiming how the company denied claims and refused to provide compensation for medical bills, leading to outrage and dueling further hatred for the healthcare system. This incident has sparked debates about the inadequacies surrounding the healthcare system and how private insurance companies in the US are only profit-driven leading to further discussions of the reform needed in the future.

#### Suspect and arrest

The suspect, Luigi Mangione, is a 26 man originally from Maryland was born to a wealthy and prominent family having been sent to a prestigious private school before graduating as valedictorian and attending an Ivy League school. According to friends he seemed to have 'everything going for him' raising questions about his true motives and intentions. Friends and acquaintances of Mangione have been left stunned following his arrest, claiming they 'never expected him to act out violently' saying it was completely out of character for him.

While his motive is still unclear, and he is not a recorded customer of United Healthcare, people alleged after a surfing accident from his time in Hawaii and his debilitating back pain from the incident his views of the medical care system has significantly changed, perhaps leading him to resent individuals like Thompson.

December 9th - On monday after a Mcdonald's worker in Altoona, Pennsylvania called 911 to report a sighting of the UHC CEO killer, police quickly apprehended him and claimed he was in possession of a 'gun, bullets, multiple fake IDs and cash'. Mr Mangione also had a handwritten document that expressed "ill will" towards corporate America and included writings such as "frankly, these parasites had it coming", according to police.

#### **Public reaction and support for Mangione**

Public opinion has been mixed on Thompson's death. Although many people have expressed their condolences for his family, there has been an apparent outpouring of compassion for Mangione on the internet. Social media platforms have developed into platforms for people to share their own experiences with inadequate healthcare coverage, financial difficulties, and claim denials. Mangione has become a reluctant symbol of frustration with the American healthcare system for some because of his alleged crime. Maybe people have dealt with similar difficulties regarding insurance agencies and the healthcare system, causing people all over the nation to share their support and sympathy for Mangione. He has also gained national attention for his good looks with people all over making 'edits' of him, he has successfully captured the attention of many, a new heartthrob in the making?



#### Significance of incident

Frequently criticized by the public, UnitedHealthcare has been the subject of legal action and accusations of unethical behavior, including refusing care to elderly people. Although the company promised to fully cooperate with authorities and offered condolences to Thompson's family, the event has sparked calls for major reform in the healthcare industry.

The murder has brought to light long-standing resentment towards the healthcare sector, which many believe puts profits before people. The attack has become a focal point for conversations about healthcare reform as to its symbolic aspect and its direct criticism of company practices. Sympathy for Mangione and public sorrow over Thompson's passing highlight how urgently fundamental changes must be made.

#### The future: looking forward

Luigi Mangione's trial will be remembered as a significant event, and the outcome is unpredictable where Luigi could either end up a free man or on death row. After facing court in Pennsylvania he is expected to be extradited to New York where he will face charges of first degree murder among others, something his lawyers hope to avoid. He has also recently hired a new attorney, the former chief assistant district attorney of NY, who is interestingly married to Sean 'Diddy' Combs' attorney.

Beyond the judicial system, Thompson's murder has raised awareness of healthcare reform. The incident highlights widespread public discontent with actions believed to be putting profit before patient care. The tragedy might serve as a catalyst for legislators and activists to demand more government-led healthcare solutions, increased transparency, and stronger rules for insurance firms. As the trial progresses, it may act as a catalyst for structural reform, rekindling pressing discussions on corporate accountability and equity in the American healthcare system.

## SYRIA'S CIVIL WAR

The Syrian Civil War, now over a decade old, has left an everlasting mark on the global landscape. What began as part of the broader Arab Spring protests in 2011 against President Bashar al-Assad's regime quickly escalated into a multifaceted conflict involving multiple international actors, rebel groups, and extremist organizations.

Initially, the uprising was driven by demands for political freedom, economic opportunity, and an end to corruption. However, the Assad government's harsh crackdown on protesters led to widespread violence, transforming peaceful demonstrations into armed rebellion. The conflict drew in various factions, including the Free Syrian Army, Islamist groups like Jabhat al-Nusra, and later, ISIS, which declared a caliphate over parts of Syria and Iraq.

Foreign intervention soon complicated the war's dynamics. Russia backed Assad with military support, while the United States, Turkey, and various Gulf states supported different opposition groups. By the late 2010s, the Assad regime, bolstered by Russian and Iranian support, regained control over most of the country, though pockets of resistance persisted. The war has severely damaged Syria's infrastructure, economy, and social fabric, leaving a legacy of trauma and division.

As of now, while the intensity of the conflict has waned, the war's end remains elusive, with ongoing skirmishes, foreign occupation in parts of the country, and a humanitarian crisis that continues to demand international attention. The path to peace, reconciliation, and rebuilding in Syria seems fraught with challenges, highlighting the enduring scars of this brutal conflict.
